

Reading Miles

Each time a child reads outside of school, they collect 10 miles. Each week, we count the miles collected and recorded in reading diaries and add them together. Once 10,000 miles have been accumulated collectively as a school, we have a themed day. The theme is different cities/countries around the world. Our first destination was Paris and we had an excellent French Day. Thereafter, the children get to vote from a choice of two, for the next destination that we are going to be aiming for. On the theme day, we learn and share facts about the destination. The children dress up to the theme (as simple as colours from the country's flag). We share traditional tales set in that destination or about that destination. Additionally, different activities are also planned from different areas of the curriculum.
