







How did Frida Kahlo paint key moments of her life and paint expression?		 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The nose should be in the centre of the face so a guideline down the middle helps. • The end of the nose comes halfway between the chin and the eye line. • The bottom lip should rest on a line halfway between the end of the nose and the chin. • The corners of the mouth should be in line with the pupils of the eyes. <p>Mexican folk art and culture is full of bright colours and geometric patterns.</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • describe the aspects of the surrealist movement? • express my opinion of the surrealism in paintings? • apply aspects of surrealism to my own artwork? • explain what an autobiographical artist does? • identify emotions from a painting? • express emotions though my own artwork?
