


## A woman of masculine bravery:

The life of Brilliana, Lady Harley (1598-1643)









The Battle of Mortimer's Cross was a key battle in the **War** of the Roses, between House Lancaster (red) and House York (white). King Edward IV was crowned after the battle. He was a Mortimer grandson.

Roger Mortimer III was hanged for being a **traitor** to the crown in 1330.
