Explain that God is Trinity: Father, Son and Holy spirit, with support.

Explain that Christians believe God sent Jesus to save his people.

Explain that Jesus is God.

Talk about why Christians spend their lives learning about God.

Talk about what the Holy Spirit is.

Explain that God is Trinity: Father, Son and Holy spirit.

Explain that Christians believe the Father (God) creates, sent his Son (Jesus) to save his people and the Son sends the Holy Spirit to his followers.

Explain that Jesus, the son of God is the embodiment of God.

Explain that Christians spend their whole lives learning more and more about God.

Explain that the Holy Spirit is God's power at work in the world.

Confidently explain that God is Trinity: Father, Son and Holy spirit and what this means.

Explain that Christians believe the Father (God) creates, sent his Son (Jesus) to save his people and the Son sends the Holy Spirit to his followers and discuss why they think he did this.

Explain that Jesus, the son of God is the embodiment of God.

Discuss why Christians spend their lives learning about God and list ways Christians do this.

Explain that the Holy Spirit is God's power at work in the world and how Christians believe this power works.
