Stress Placement. Words that end in a consonant (apart from 'n' or 's') should be stressed on the last syllable as in fav-or. For words that end in a vowel or 'n' and 's' it is normally second to last syllable like ce-bo-llas. • Accents. Accents can only be written over vowels in Spanish and indicate the vowel is stressed – regardless of the other rules! As seen in ju-dí-as. • Ñ tilde. This changes the 'n' to a 'ny' sound like in the English word 'onion'. It is another letter in Spanish not just another phoneme.
