For words that end in a vowel or 'n' and 's' it is normally the second to last syllable like naran-ja.</p>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ask and answer the question '¿Cómo te llamas?' in Spanish.
Can I Ask and answer the question 'What is your name?' in Spanish.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Accents. Accents can only be written over vowels in Spanish and indicate the vowel is stressed – regardless of the other rules! As seen in có-mo. 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Say the numbers 1-10 in Spanish.
Colours	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ñ tilde. This changes the 'n' to a 'ny' sound like in the English word 'onion'. 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Know 10 colours and how to say which is my favourite colour in Spanish
