Accents can only be written over vowels in Spanish and indicate the vowel is stressed – regardless of the other rules! I do not like apples.</p> <p><b>grammar</b> Nouns in Spanish can be masculine or feminine and singular or plural. This means that determiners can have different forms in Spanish. Singular determiner 'a/an' Plural determiner 'the'</p>	say 5 fruit nouns with their determiners in Spanish.
