## Nursery Places

Our breakfast and afterschool provision is now in place for children from 3 upwards. Please contact the office to book your child in. Rise opens at 8am and Shine runs until 4.30 (originally we advertised this to run until 5.30 but we have not had enough interest to make this slot viable, we will continue to monitor this should demand increase).

Breakfast Club- RISE - Takes place in the school hall, children sit around a table and have a choice of cereal, toast and other breakfast items. They then play board games and do activities. When school starts they are taken through to school and nursery.

After School -SHINE - Takes place in the school hall with a snack table and a relaxing area, children are able to choose the activities that take place on a day-to-day basis with favourites including outdoor games, lego, drawing, craft and board games.

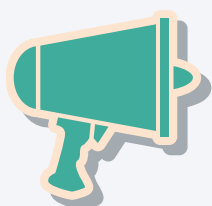
