-  Go on a wonder walk and take pictures of things that make you say "Wow!"


-  Create an instrument using recycled materials.


SPICY CHALLENGES

Worth 3 points each!

-  Learn a poem that you can recite by heart.
-  Create a quiz about the different things you have learnt this half term.

-  Make a scene showing an explorer on their mission, this could be 2D or 3D and any explorer you like, deep sea, space, the dessert, polar, forest or mountain.

-  Find out about a famous musician and listen to their music, write a review of their work or create a piece of art about the music.

-  Go on an animal hunt and classify them into invertebrates and vertebrates or by using an animal classification key.
