Physical Development.

Physical activities will be carried out daily throughout Nursery, this will be inside and outdoors. <u>Maths</u>

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This half term we will be continuing our work on subitising items and saying what we can see. This is a simple activity that you can carry out while driving around in the car whilst looking out of the window, 'I can see 2 cows!'

Recognising and completing repeating patterns, matching numerals and recognising colours will be throughout our play.

Communication and Language

The children will be encouraged to join in Huddle time as we talk about their own experiences. and ideas around food and where it comes from. Children will have opportunities to enhance listening skills as they listen to stories. We will be learning a new nursery rhyme each week with actions, this will be on Seesaw to practise at home too.

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will be given many opportunities to paint and create objects and artwork of meaning to them using a variety of materials both indoors and outdoors. The children will have opportunity to interact with small world set ups and will learn how to create their own storylines in play. The children will be encouraged to explore sound using instruments and objects in their environment.
