### SCHOOL FUNDRAISER

National Will Writers are offering a Will service in return for a donation to your school. Any parent or teacher can use this service to get a legally binding professionally written Will. The amount of the donation is up to the person taking the service. In return they will have a consultation with one of our professional team members to discuss their wishes and have their Will drafted for them.

### THE FACTS

- Over 70% of parents with children under the age of 18 do not have a Will.
- A Will is the only place you can legally name guardians, without this they will be handled by social services.
- Without a Will your assets could be locked down or controlled by someone else.
- If you are not married, then your partner may not inherit anything.
- If you are married your spouse doesn't automatically inherit everything.

### HOW IT WORKS

Scan the QR code or head to the link provided to start the Will Writing Service. Everyone will have a consultation where they can ask any questions and discuss their wishes before we issue a fully bound, formal legal Will. **Behaviour** - As a school and nursery we are adopting the restorative practice approach. This is a reflective method that rebuilds relationships and enables all children to develop skills that are essential to life. This is not a huge change to how we have always done things at Leintwardine. We will start in nursery by talking about how we are feeling and how we can tell what others are feeling. When things do not go right we will be talking about what has happened using questions like the ones shown here, we will be giving children a lot of support to help them to verbalise and will be using pictures to help.
