## MATHS

Year 1 will continue to develop their understanding of number by looking at numbers and calculating within 20.

Year 2 will work on multiplication and division (Particularly multiplying and dividing by 2, 5, 10) and then money (recognising British notes and coins and solving simple money problems)

## ART

In Art we will be exploring lines and patterns using both pencils and paints. We will look carefully at the work of Paul Klee and draw together our knowledge and skills to produce our own artwork in the same style.

## SCIENCE

In Science, we will be investigating materials which are waterproof and absorbent, carrying out a number of investigations to find the best materials for different jobs.

## TOPIC

We will be looking at maps to discover the world's oceans and continents. We will learn about human and physical features in our local area, using and drawing our own maps.



## ENGLISH

In English we will be looking at the fabulous story of The Crow's Tale which tells of how the crow got his distinctive black feathers. During this unit we will develop our understanding of different sentence structures and build a rich vocabulary to create expanded noun phrases and vary our verbs and adverbs.

## RE AND PSHE

In RE, we will continue to explore the life of Jewish people answering the question 'Who is Jewish and how do they live?'

In PSHE we will be thinking about our aspirations for life and how we can reach our potential.

## COMPUTING AND MUSIC

In computing we will create pictograms to display data using software in PurpleMash.
